School Uniform at Wembury Primary School

At Wembury Primary School we do have school uniform. This consists of a jumper/cardigan, white or royal blue shirt/T-Shirt/Polo shirt and grey skirt/tunic/trousers or shorts. There is no set requirement to purchase these items through a particular supplier. We do work with a company 'MacPac' that you can purchase Wembury Primary School branded items from. Uniform in our school colours can also be purchased at reasonable prices from supermarkets and clothing stores. The uniform

- White or royal blue polo shirt required
- Choice of six colours sweatshirt / cardigan with or without school logo (Royal blue, Light Blue, Purple, Red, Yellow or Green) Sweatshirts/cardigans without logos can be bought from local supermarkets -required
- Grey trousers, shorts, pinafore or skirt required
- Summer dresses check or stripe optional
- Grey/white or dark socks/tights required
- Waterproof coat -required
- Sensible school shoes/boots (No trainers) -required
- Sandals may be worn in the summer months but No Croc type shoes or flip flops- optional

During the summer months, please provide your child with a plain sun cap/hat and ensure sun cream is applied prior to arrival at school.

PE Kit

- Plain white T-shirt (no logos, unless school logo) required
- Plain black shorts required
- Plain black jogging bottoms- optional for winter months
- Trainers -required

Swimming Kit

Swimming hats should be worn with long hair if possible however if not, it must be tied back securely. No jewellery should be worn. Swimming costumes should not provide drag in the water and must be of suitable design. Goggles can be worn if required.

Hair

Parents should ensure that their child's hair style is not unconventional, multicoloured, with unnatural hair colours.

Make-up Make up, of any sort during school hours is not permitted.

Water Bottles As a school we operate access to water throughout the day, through pupils having their own water bottle. There has been extensive scientific evidence to support the benefits of water. Some of these are:

- Helps to prevent a range of short and long-term health problems such as headaches, bladder & bowel problems
- Provides a source for healthy & low cost hydration 2 Reduces tiredness
- Can have a positive effect on pupils' concentration

Bottles can be purchased through the school and it is the parents' responsibility for leaning the bottles daily at home, and refilling with water only.

It is recommended that every child attending school carries a book bag /small backpack
