

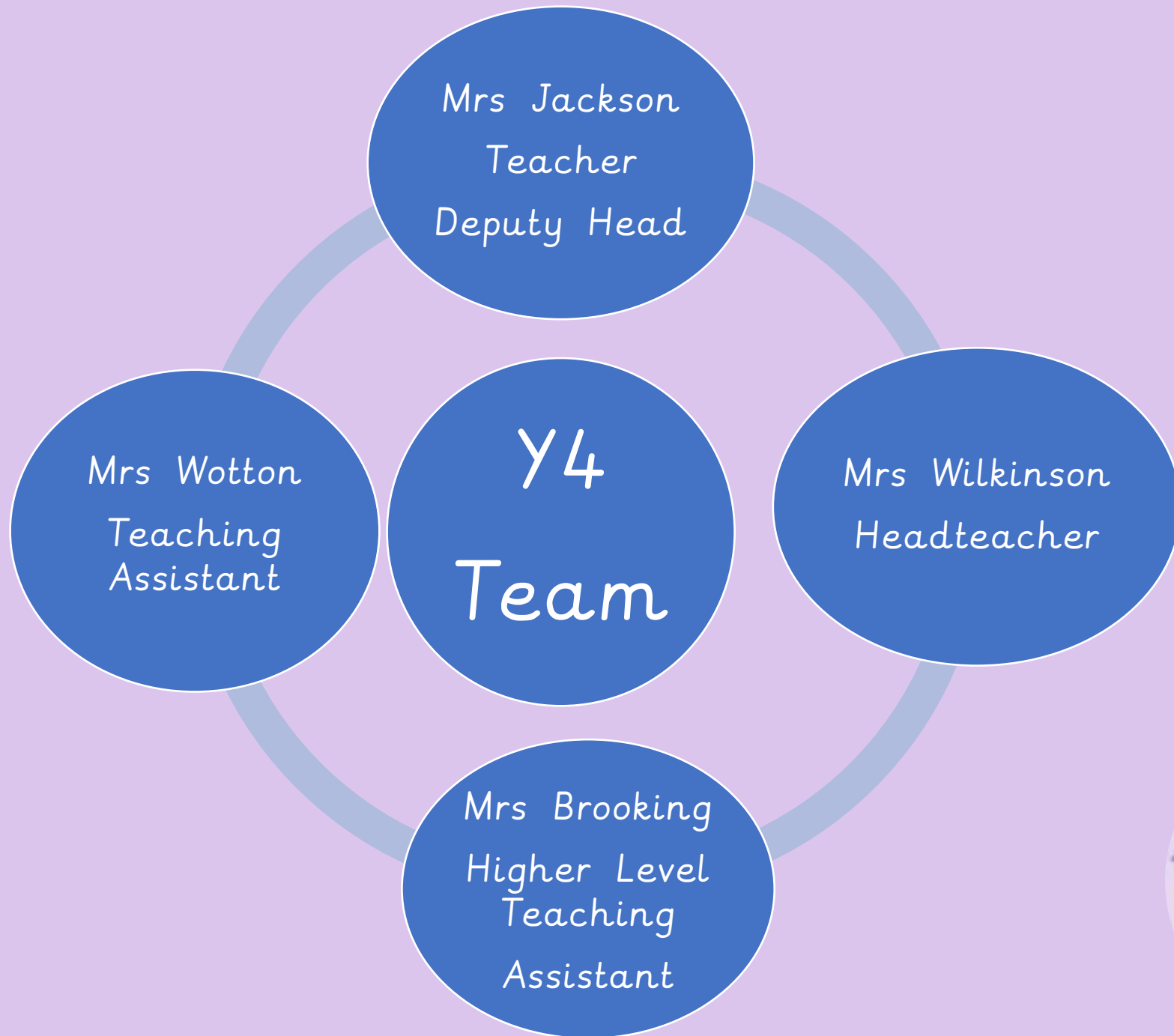

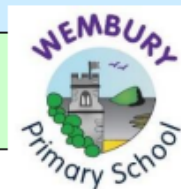

- Respect each other – we are all different.



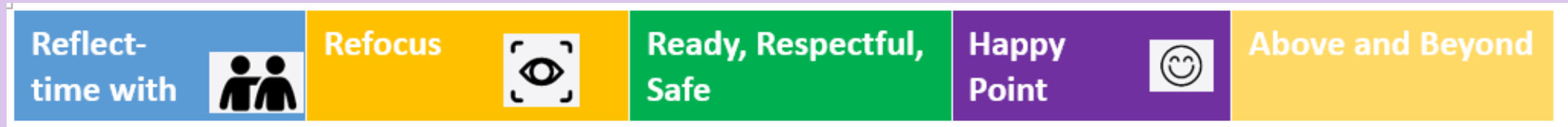
Behaviour and Relationship Policy

'Be Ready, Be Respectful and Be Safe'

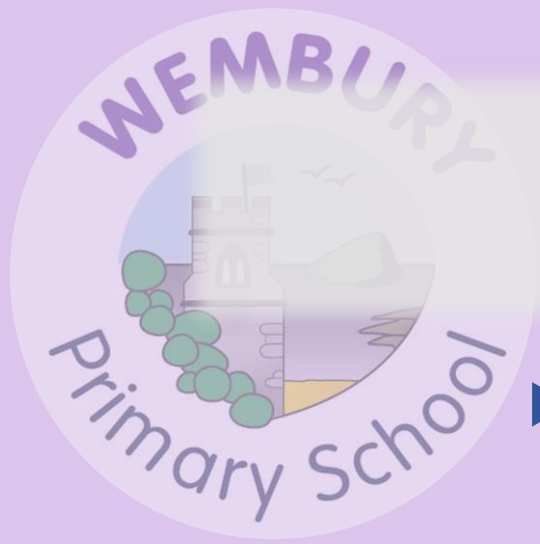
which can be applied to a variety of situations and are taught and modelled explicitly.

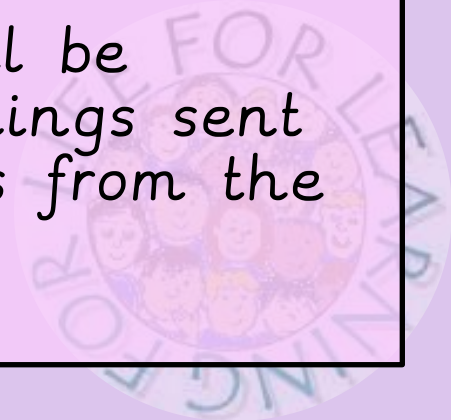


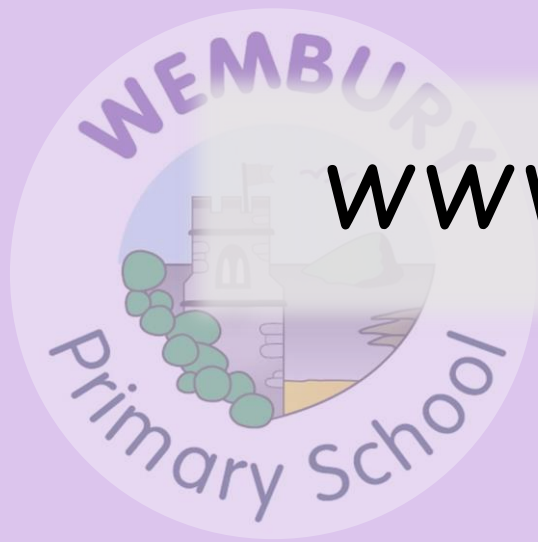
Homework Arrangements

Spellings will build on class learning and will be assessed in class the following Monday. Spellings sent home will include 5 focus words and 5 words from the Year 3/4 list.



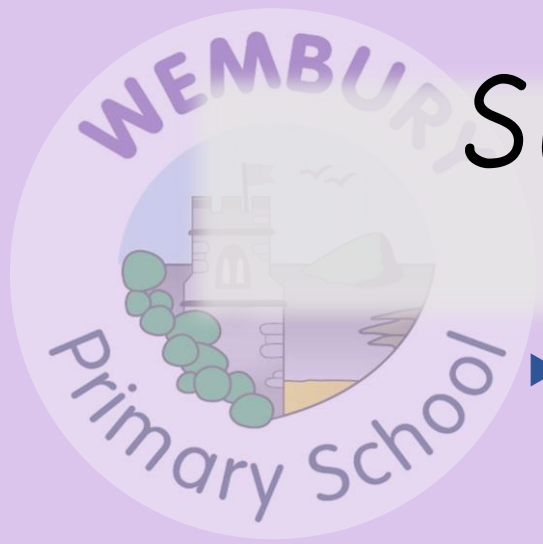

On average, the check should take no longer than 5 minutes to complete.



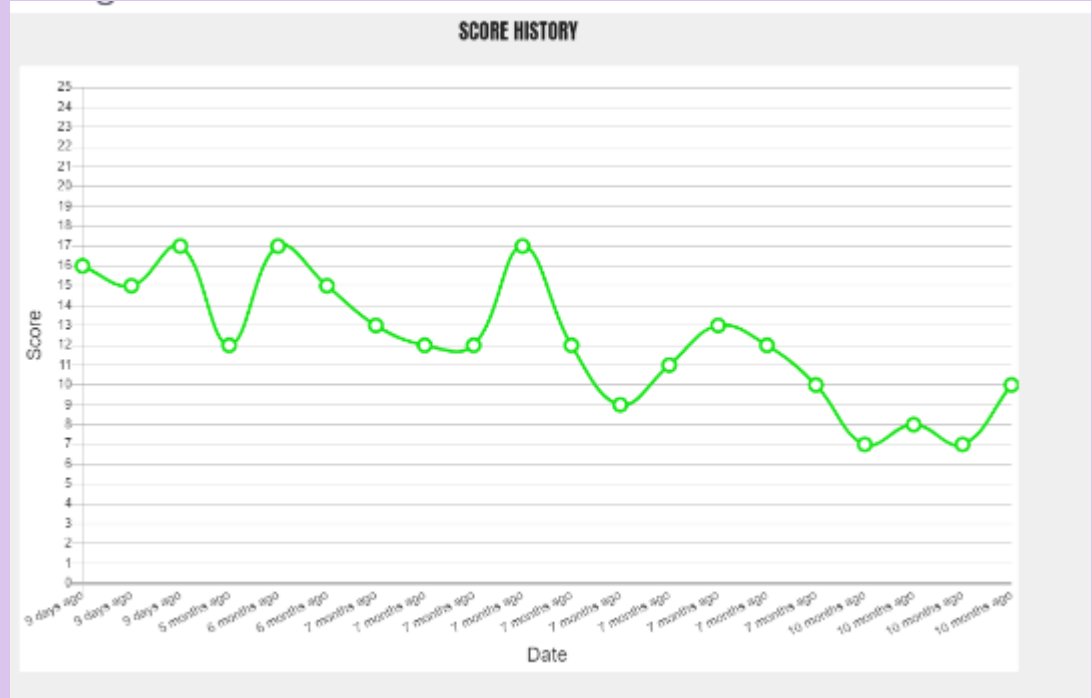

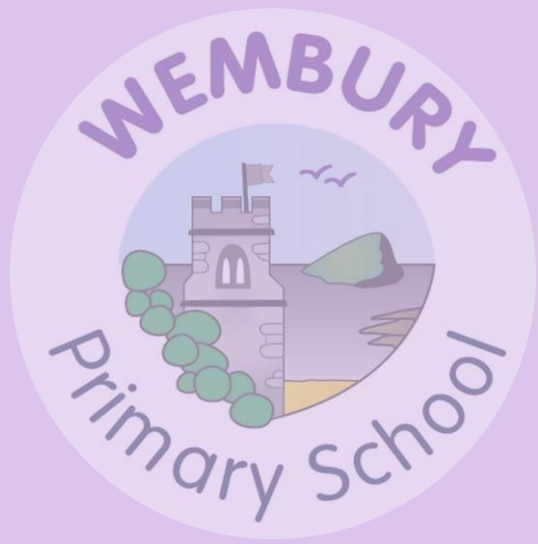

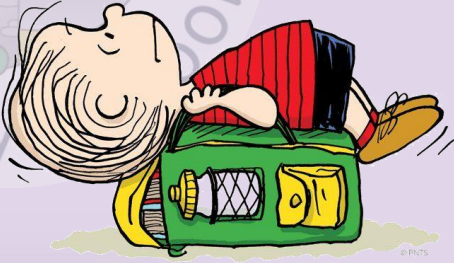

Children to wear appropriate black school shoes.



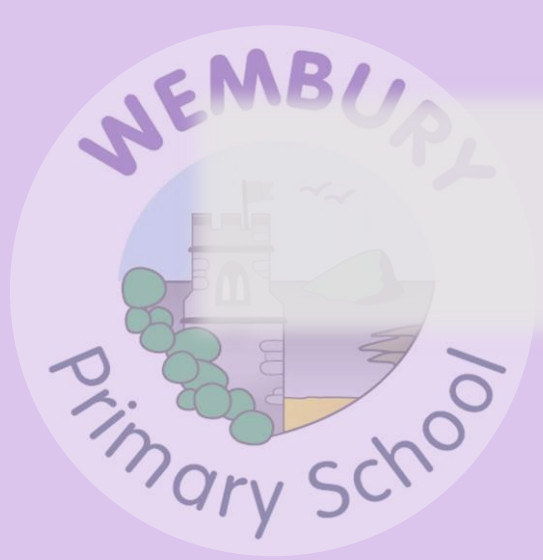
Sweatshirts and Cardigans
