

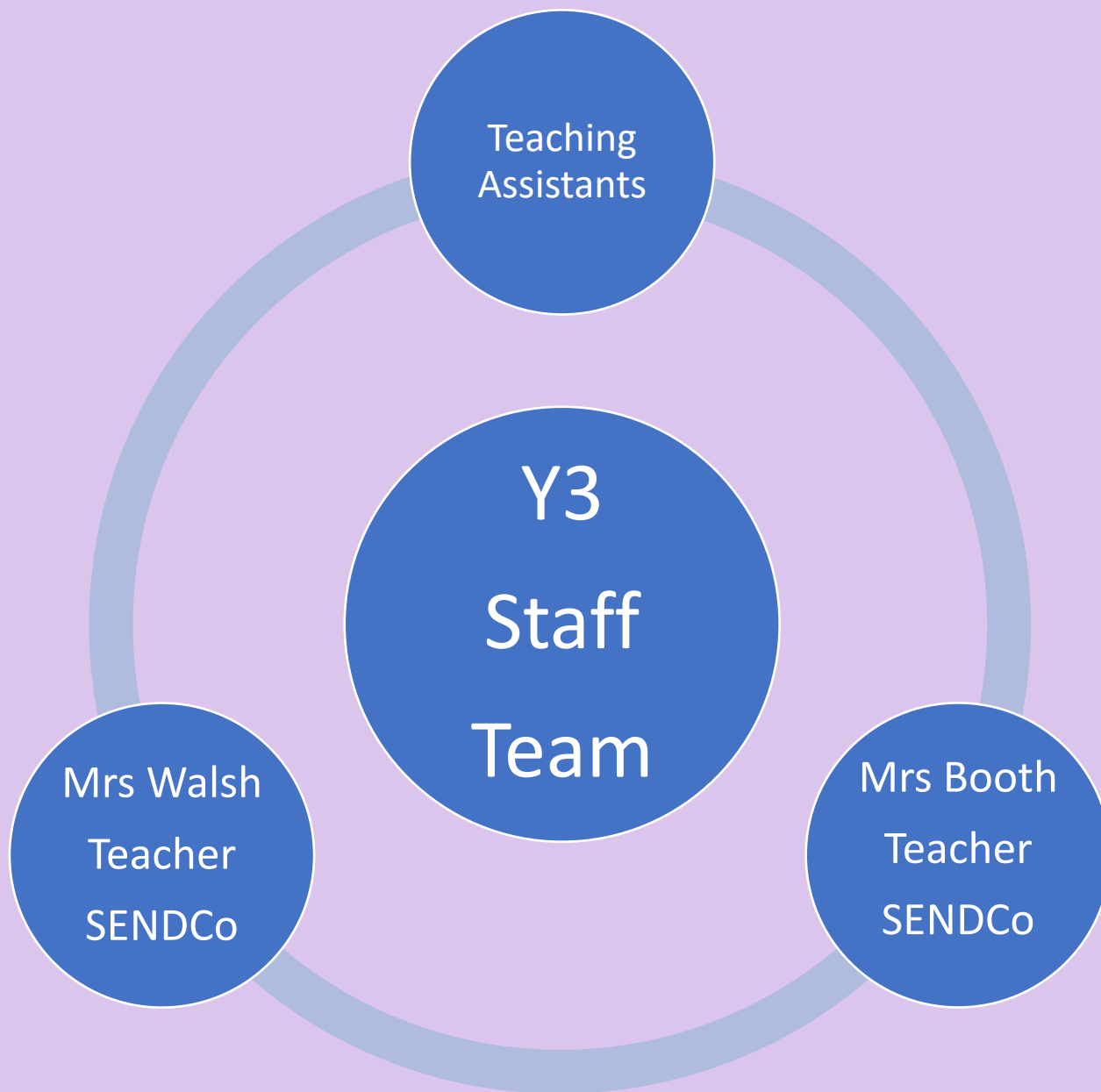

- ▶ Also, if there is anything that is worrying your child, please let us know as soon as possible so that we can support appropriately: y3@wembury-primary.devon.sch.uk



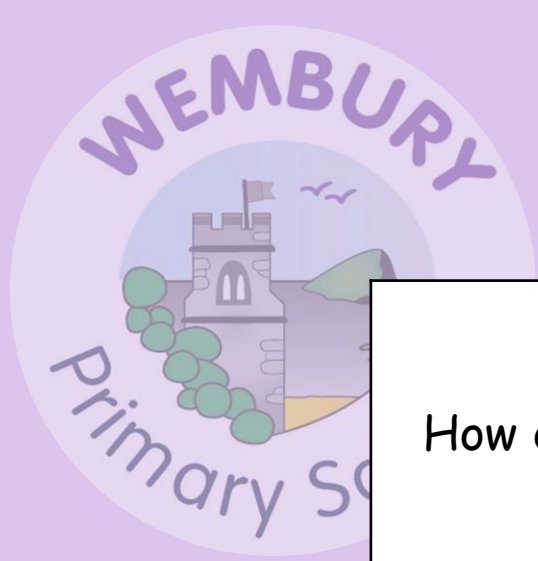
Behaviour and Relationship Policy

and Be Safe'**

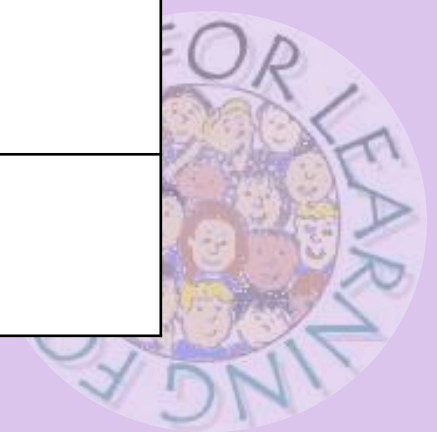
which can be applied to a
