It's been another busy week at Wembury!!

Year 3 have been out and about this week, taking a walk to inspire their writing. We are currently in British Science Fortnight. To start the fortnight, the children took part in a live science assembly on the theme of light sources. The astronaut Tim Peake joined in too!

On Friday, Plymouth Aquarium will be visiting and will be leading a *Slimy Seas* assembly.

Olli from the Arena School Sports Partnership joined Year 2 for the whole day on Tuesday. The theme was *Healthy Bodies, Healthy Minds*. The children took part in a range of activities that explored their feelings and how to work better as a team. They particularly enjoyed taking part in Pilates, making rockets and volcanoes.



Year 1 have been creative in our Forest School area. They experimented with mark making using natural colours. Their challenge was, they had no pencils! Everyone created their own nature postcard using mud, dandelions, daisies, leaves to make colours and shapes.



Next week, the children from Year 1 to Year 6 will be taking part in Robotics Workshops. These

workshops will involve building robotic models and will also include elements of coding for the Key Stage 2 classes.
