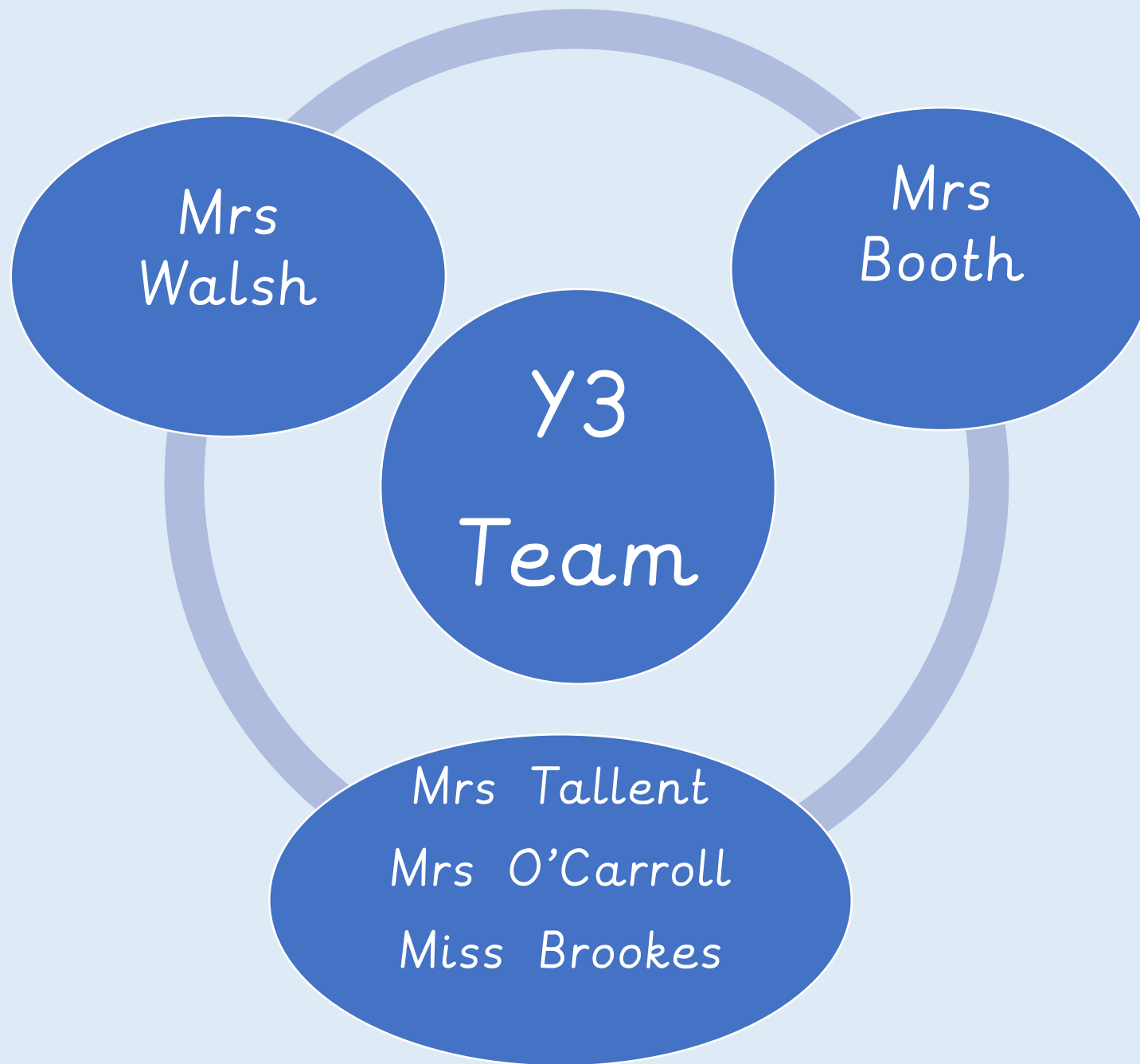
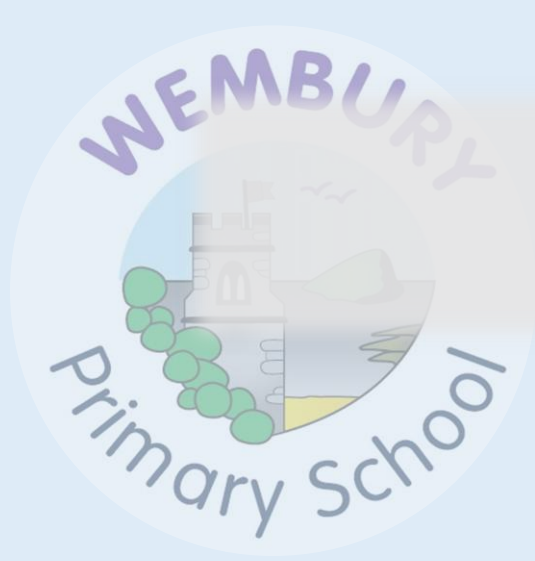

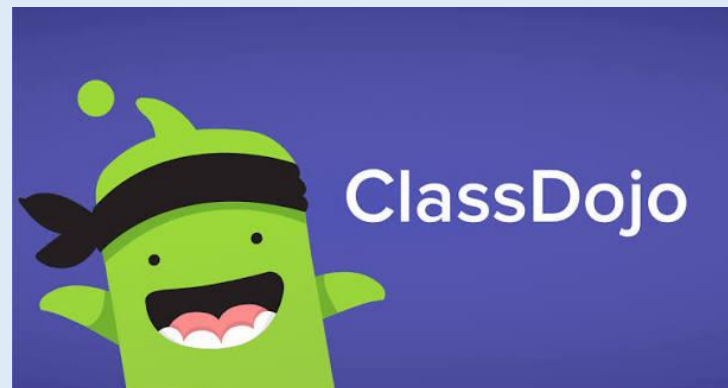

- Our main form of communication now is via ClassDojo. This is a two - way platform where we can communicate with yourselves.



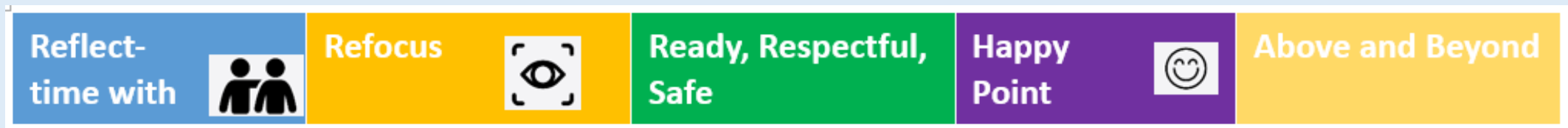
Behaviour and Relationship Policy

‘Our Behaviour Horizon’





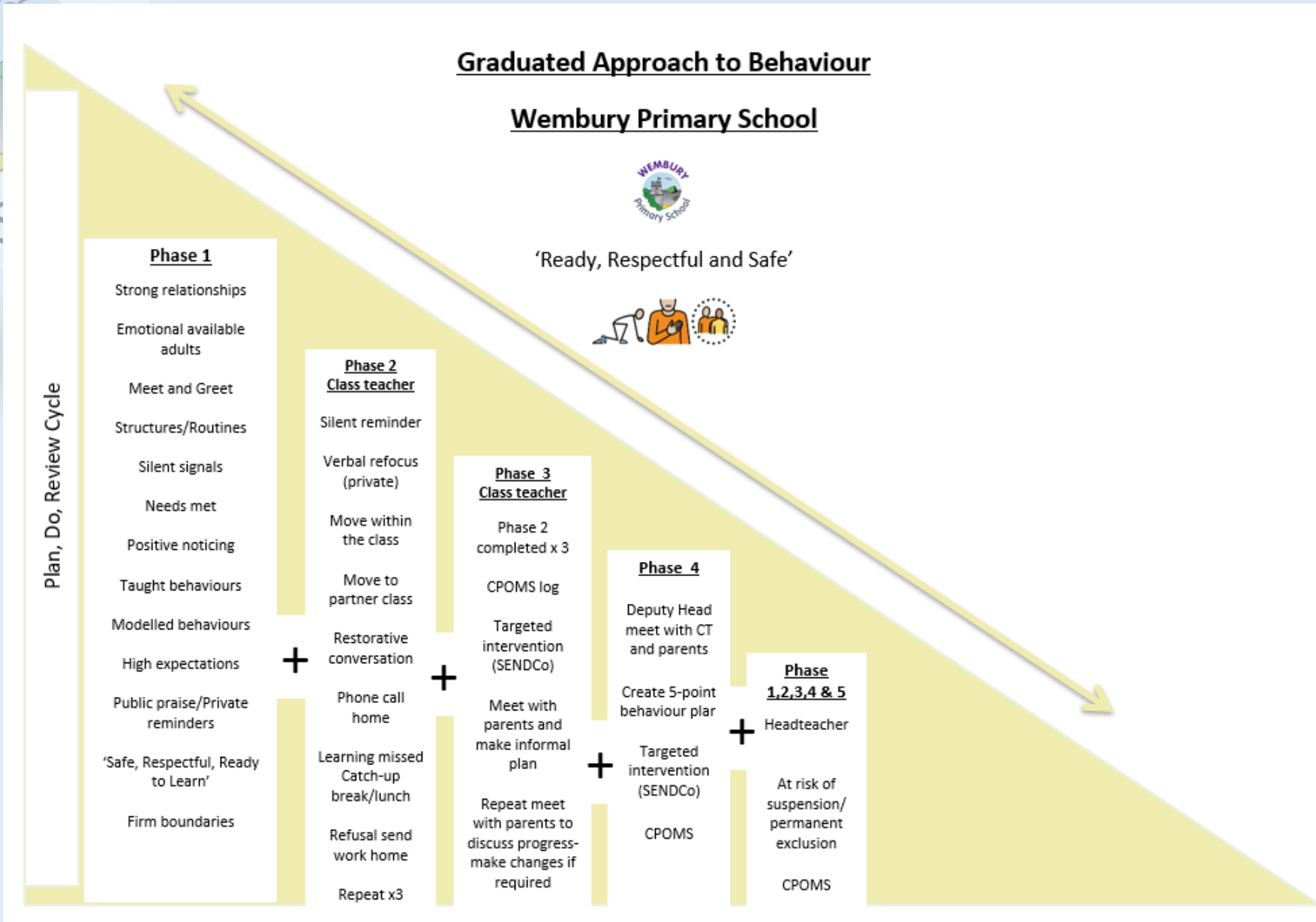
Working together in partnership

Our Graduated Behaviour Approach



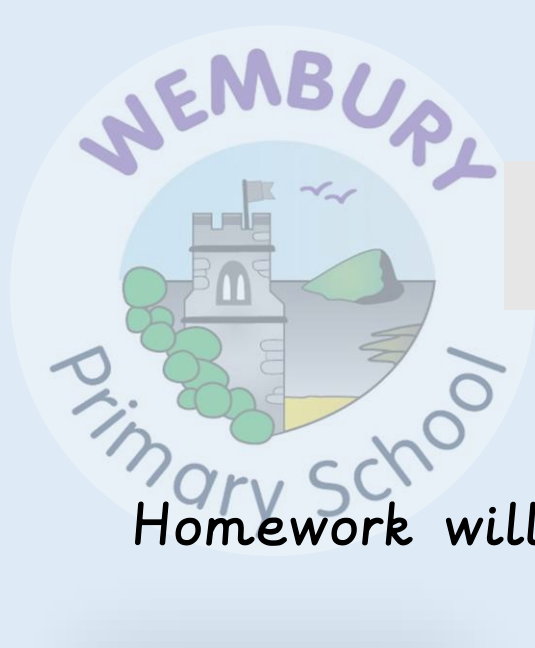


PSHE

- Relationships and Sexual Education (RSE) – taught in the Summer term.





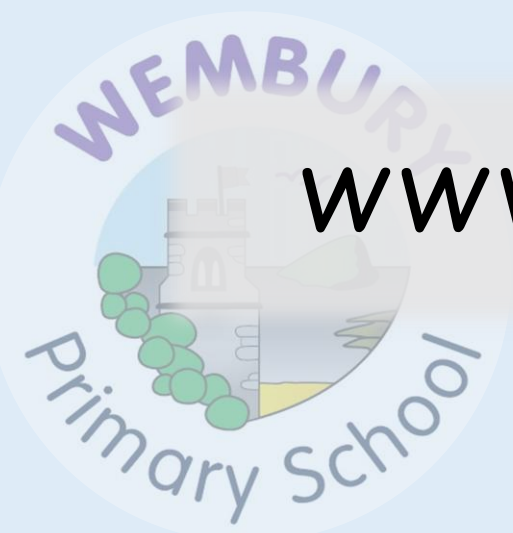
Homework Arrangements

Homework will be sent home on a Wednesday.

- At least 15 minutes of reading everyday is crucial (books can be returned whenever they are completed) If children score 80% or more they will receive a sticker for their bookmark.
- Maths and Spellings will be set each week.

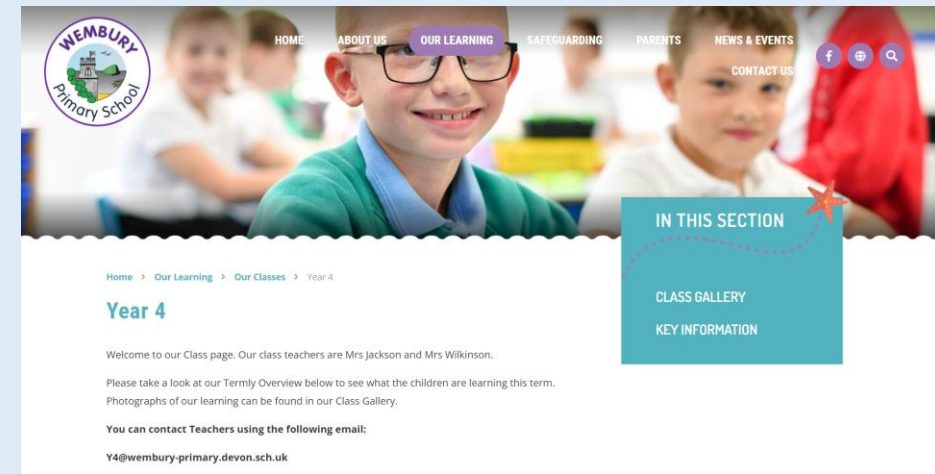
Spellings will build on class learning and will be assessed in class the following week. Spellings sent home will include 5 focus words and 5 words from the Year 3/4 list.

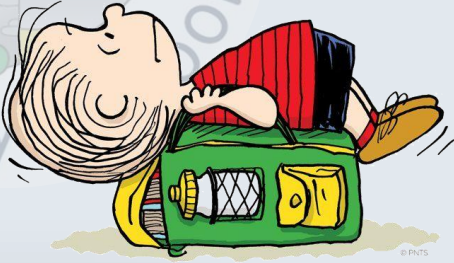
Supporting Children with Special Needs

From September 2026 – blue, jade or purple jumpers to be purchased.

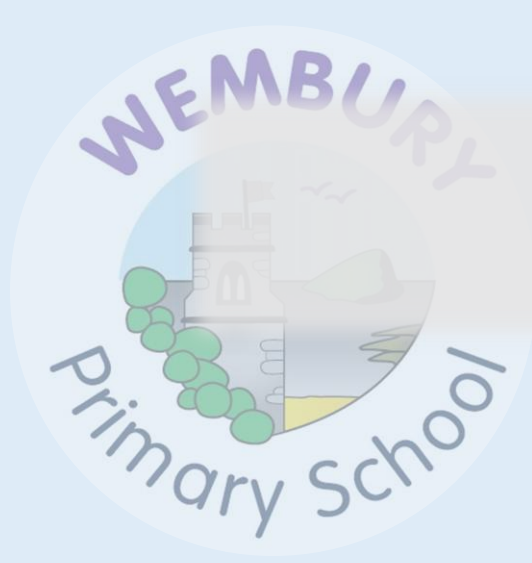
